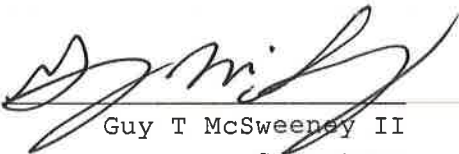
End of year goal is to have 20 TOR nodes (servers) running by end of year. We are currently at 14 and need to find additional providers to complete our goal. Currently monitoring node speeds to verify if we should stick with the current provider or move to another one.

Start to save up and prepare paperwork for ARIN ASN application. Believe the application fee is \$550 for the ASN and then \$150 for a single IPv6 block.
